New Order! Factory Activity Touches 16-mth High in July

PMI at 59.1; sales rise at fastest pace in nearly five years, propel production growth

Gaining Momentum

Rise in output and sales



New Delhi: India's manufacturing activity rose to a 16-month high of 59.1 in July, driven by robust growth in new orders, output and stock of purchases. The IHS Markit Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) compiled by S&P Global, rose 0.4 to 59.1 from 58.7 in June 2025 and 58.1 in July 2024.

"The Indian manufacturing sector has benefited from strong growth in new orders and output," said Prakash Chandra, chief economist at IHS.

The survey respondents attributed the increase in new orders to the resurgent demand conditions and effective marketing initiatives.

Sales rose at the fastest pace in almost five years, propelling production growth to a 16-month high.

"Despite this expansion in new orders, the strongest recorded in over 14 years, according to the survey, the business sentiment showed signs of strain."

"Business confidence fell to its lowest level in three years due to concerns over competition and inflationary pressures," the survey said.

Manufacturers remained optimistic about output growth over the coming 12 months, but the inflation outlook remained the most pessimistic in three years.

"Aid in solving business confidence, better manufacturing have extra staff at the slowest rate since November 2023," said Prakash.

While the demand for new orders was the strongest in over 14 years, the survey also noted that the rate of change in output and sales was slower than in June.

New Delhi: India-US talks on the bilateral trade deal negotiations may require a reset through a conversation at the highest level, Mark T. Esper, senior adviser, US India Strategic Partnership Forum, and former assistant US Trade Representative, said. He said there is a strong likelihood the US will make progress and conclude a short-term

agreement and a longer-term bilateral Trade Agreement. "At this point, I think a conversation between the President (Donald Trump) and Prime Minister Narendra Modi is clear the air and possibly even set the terms for a deal," Esper, who led trade negotiations under the previous Trump regime, told ET. However, he said this may require a meeting off period once new leadership is placed in the White House.

Auto Cos on Road to Meet PLI Goals a Year Earlier

New Delhi: The Central government expects beneficiaries of the production-linked incentive programme for automobiles and auto components (PLI-Auto) to achieve targets and exhaust the scheme funds in the 50th year itself.

The government approved the scheme in September 2020 with a ₹2,95,000 crore liability outlay, seeking to create global champions in the automobile and auto component space. Investors are awarded for meeting goals including incremental production, investment and export value addition from 2020-24 onwards. A number of

are completely excluded from it. Tata Motors, Mahindra & Mahindra, Bajaj Auto, Ola Electric and TVS Motor Company, are among the major auto

mobile companies that have raised claims under the scheme till now. "Budgetary fund allocation for the current fiscal is expected to be exhausted in a few months," the trend suggests there will be much higher disbursements in the next two years.

Another senior official told ET Budget 2025 of car marked ₹2,80,000 crore far below under this scheme. Three automobile companies have raised claims totalling more than ₹2,900 crore for

achieving the scheme's goals in FY25. Officials said ₹233 crore have been released so far for FY24.

Officials said the beneficiary has invested ₹1,600 crore in 2024-25, outpacing the scheme's objective by almost 20%. This propelled the cumulative investment linked to the scheme to almost ₹50,000 crore, or 70% of the five-year target.

While automobile companies are firing well, there are concerns about component makers not meeting goals. Of the over 70 auto component makers that were shortlisted for incentives, less than 10 have raised claims.

The official said bank guarantees will be forfeited for players that do not meet commitments.

While trade thrives will ultimately harm US consumers by driving up domestic supply, for India any "short-term losses" will only strengthen the imperative of becoming self-reliant in critical sectors, the IIS affiliate added.

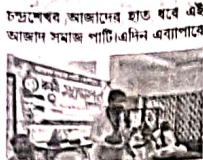
